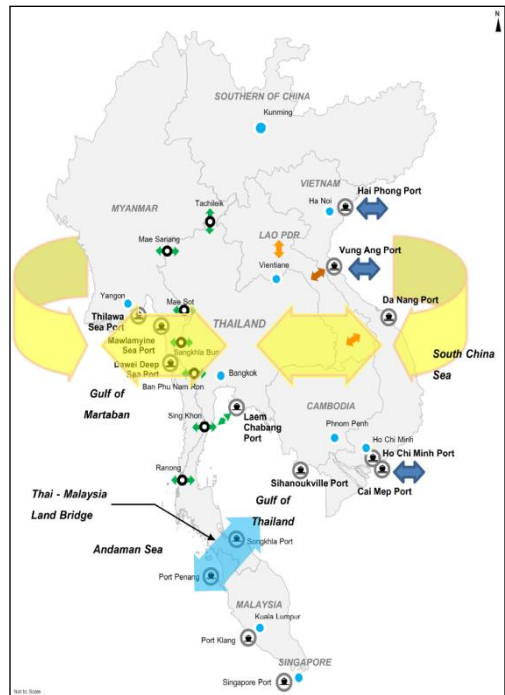
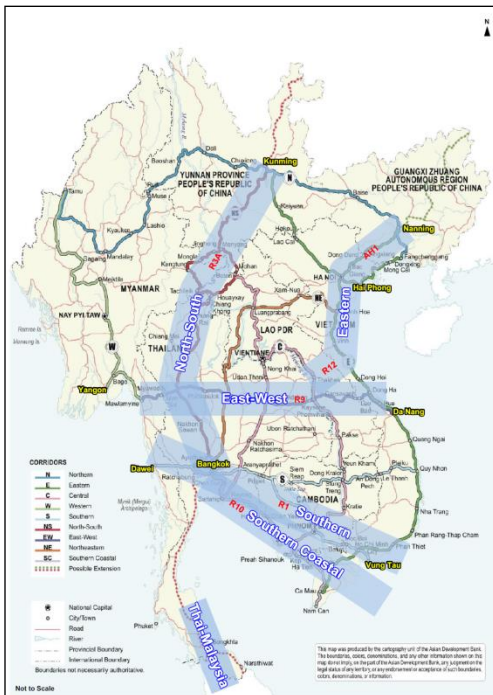


A Study of Transport Costs and International Logistics in the Greater Mekong Subregion (GMS)
