- Establishment of the criteria of road and public transport hierarchies and investigation on the application of transport concepts, criteria and policies to the development of Bangkok's fast growing suburban fringes.
- Development of a small scale pilot scheme for a trip rate database to demonstrate the usefulness of information on trip generation characteristics of different categories of land use in predicting the traffic impact of development.
