The Bangkok Plan's transportation strategy was based on the following key transport sector policies:

I. Public Transit

Establish a high quality, fixed-rail Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) system in ten years sequenced with land use proposals

Create an integrated public transit system with buses complementing MTR

Develop waterway services and paratransit modes to fill in gaps in the rest of transit system.



II. The Road System

Coordinate current commitments to create an integrated arterial network comprising expressways, primary arterial routes, and secondary roads

Optimize capacity of existing network at minimum cost through traffic management measures.

III. Freight Transportation

Promote rail freight opportunities

Allow free orbital movement of trucks and road freight along the Outer Ring Road and minimize through truck movement within its boundaries

Integrate existing inland waterway and seaborne freight transport with road/rail modal transfer facilities.
