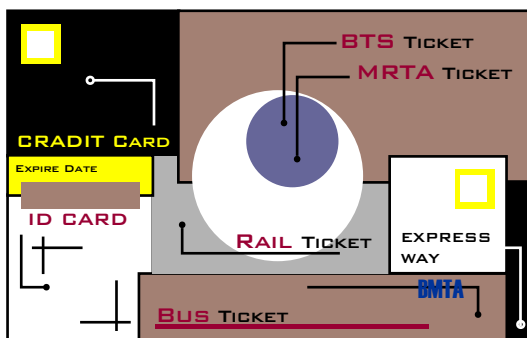


Transfer Ticketing for Mass Transit Systems

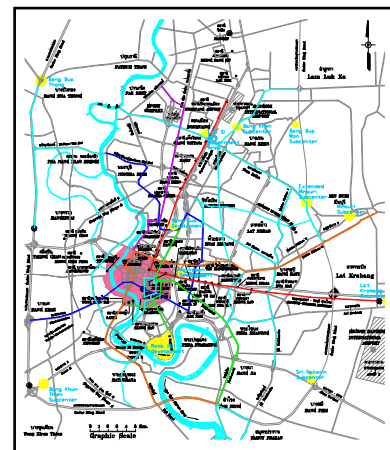

The establishment of a common ticketing system to allow interchange between mass transit lines and other public transport systems is considered to be essential to provide seamless travel opportunities that will be attractive to the motorist.
